New Key Stage 2 assessments in 2016

The 2016 KS2 assessments are the first which assess the new, more challenging national curriculum. New tests and interim frameworks for teacher assessment have been introduced to reflect the revised curriculum. Results are no longer reported as levels, and each pupil will now receive their test results as a scaled score and teacher assessments based on the standards in the interim framework. Nationally only 53% of pupils reached the new expected standard in reading, writing and mathematics. At St. Alban's, 92% of pupils reached the new expected standard which is testament to the children's hard work.

Because of the changes set out above, figures for 2016 are not comparable to those for earlier years. The expectations for pupils at the end of KS2 have been raised. Given the differences in the curriculum and assessments, levels are not comparable with scaled scores or teacher assessment outcomes. Fewer pupils reached the expected standard in reading than in other subjects nationally.

We are delighted with our results shown below. In every area, the children at St. Alban's exceeded national averages by some margin. The results are a tribute to the hard work of our children, staff and parents.

The KS2 tests were much harder than in previous years; however the children responded well to the challenge and have done brilliantly.

EYFS (Reception)

The Reception classes have achieved a GLD (Good Level of Development) of 91%, which is again significantly above the national average (69%).



Year 1 Phonics

The following table compares the percentages by phonics result for the school in 2016 with the national results for 2015. Well done Year 1 on such an amazing achievement.
