St Alban's School Governor's Fund

The Governors and staff at St Alban's Catholic Primary School are continually looking at ways to develop and improve the school and we are proud of the welcoming and stimulating learning environment that we provide for our children. Many developments to date have greatly enhanced the school building and facilities, including fixed seating tables for the main hall, installation of covered walkways, and playground repairs. Things we would like to do in the near future include:

- Additional LearnPads/IPads for pupils; and
- Further playground upgrades

Unfortunately, we have seen an increased pressure on finances in the last few years and we do not have the resources to pay for all such items from the school's main budget, but by collecting donations to our Governor's Fund, we can make a real difference to our school. We invite all families to make a voluntary contribution of £10 per month. Anyone who is unable to make this level of donation is welcome to make a smaller contribution. Of course, families are free to donate a larger amount if circumstances allow.

The Multi Academy Trust is a registered charity and we are therefore able to claim Gift Aid back from the Inland Revenue on eligible donations: if you are a tax payer and complete a Gift Aid declaration, **every pound donated by you is worth £1.25 to the school**, making your donation go even further! In order to maximise the benefit of our charitable status all parents that currently make donations and all those planning to start are invited to complete the Gift Aid Declaration form.
