



# Music Learning Journey - EYFS and KS1



**Folksongs:** This unit focuses on singing and performing British Isles folk songs while exploring pulse, dynamics, pitch, texture, rhythm, and dot notation, including singing in rounds and parts.

**Four Seasons:** This unit uses Vivaldi's *The Four Seasons* to develop pulse, dynamics, tempo, rhythm, and pitch through performance, improvisation, composition, and musical appraisal.

**Great Fire of London:** Inspired by the Great Fire of London, this unit develops rhythm, dynamics, notation, and ensemble performance with an introduction to Baroque music.

## Year 2

**Senses:** Using the five senses, this unit develops key musical skills through vocal and instrumental activities exploring dynamics, duration, timbre, tempo, pitch, and rhythm.

**At the sea side:** This unit explores creating and performing graphic scores, focusing on pulse, timing, and collaborative composition using symbols, pictures, and grids.

**Carnival of Animals:** This unit explores creating and performing graphic scores, focusing on pulse, timing, and collaborative composition using symbols, pictures, and grids.

## Year 1

**ELG - Traditional tales:** Inspired by traditional tales, this unit develops singing, performing, and composing skills through pitch, rhythm, and group work.

**ELG - Minibeasts:** This unit explores performing, composing, listening, and singing through music inspired by minibeasts, ending with children creating a piece based on the butterfly life cycle.

**ELG - All About Me:** exploring emotions through singing, listening, composing, and moving to music while developing an understanding of rhythm, pitch, and instrument sounds.
