# **Monday**




John 12: 12-13


# **Prayer Leader:**




# **Prayer Leader:**


Yesterday we heard about Jesus washing the disciples' feet and how we can copy His loving example by caring for others.

The Holy Spirit offers so many gifts. Love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness and self-control. He can also guide us with wisdom and give us courage.

# How can you share a gift of the Spirit with others today?

- You might choose to show kindness to someone at school.
- Or show self-control by spending less time on your device to be with others instead.


# Mark 14: 32-38


# **Prayer Leader:**

Tell Jesus about the people who need prayer that you know.

Now ask Jesus to help you to keep praying, even when it's difficult to.

You might like to pray:

Jesus, help me to pray when...



We hear in the Bible how Jesus prayed in gardens, houses, on mountains and by the sea. We too can pray to at anytime, anywhere.

#### How and where can you pray more today?

- You could say a short prayer in your head every time the bells rings during the school day.
- Or you could pray in a different place to normal, like taking a few moments for prayer during your playtime.

Share your answers with your talk partner now.


Let's be still and imagine Jesus on the Cross.

The great news is Jesus rose again and is alive so all can believe in Him and know His love today.

# How can you share the good news of Jesus' love with others today?

We adore you O Christ and we praise you, because by your Holy Cross you have redeemed the world.
